The Annual Report for the Academic year 2017-2018 for Primary is as follows.

We opened our new branch with an Orientation Session of “Sri Chaitanya Techno School’s Curriculum”.

We had Coffee meet with our primary parents to brief the Academic Curriculum for both the Lower Primary and Upper Primary children.

Lower Primary follows the Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) system and also semester pattern. Apart from exams our students are also evaluated on their Understanding, Presenting and Implementing abilities on each subject whereas Upper Primary follows term pattern (i.e.) Pre Mid-Term, Mid-Term, Post Mid-Term and Annual.

We also have Y-Lead program for our upper Primary students which is of MCQ Pattern for training the kids for the various competitive exams. Apart from academics we also concentrate on the overall development of our students through a program called “PROPEL”. A Program to Promote Enhanced learning. In this we have five different sub-programs such as Lingo Labs, Math Genie, Vikas Bhasha, Golden Hand and Manner Musketeers. We also pay attention for our slow Learners through a program called “Learners Strengthening Program (LSP)” after our school hours by conducting remedial classes.

On the same day of our Coffee meet our Primary parents inaugurated our four clubs (i.e.) Athletic Club, Ecology Club, Fine Arts Club and Astronomy Club. Each and every month all these four clubs conducted various different activities. As a part of our Co-Curricular activity for Lower Primary we had school outing program where we took our children to post office, villas, super market etc., whereas our Primary students had smart session in “Money Matters, Session inspiration”.

To update the kid’s academic performance, we constantly had Parent teacher’s conference (PTM) after each assessment. We also have Adoption Program every month in focusing on the academic improvement of the kids. Now coming to celebrations to nurture in our kids “Unity in diversity” we chaitanians celebrated all the festival in our campus apart from caste, creed and religion.

We had “Inter School Competition” in our Campus for Essay Writing, Poetry Writing, Chitrakala, Photography, Spell Bee and Handwriting. Solo Singing and Dance on 26th November where students from other schools actively participated in all the competitions and won medals and certificates. The Annual Report for the Academic year 2017-2018 for High School i.e. grade 6 and grade 7 is as follows.

We at Sri Chaitanya Techno School believe in the holistic development of your child. We have inculcated the Smart Living Program into our curriculum wherein every 2 months a topic is chosen and we conduct various activities based on the topic. For the academic year 2017-2018 the topics chosen have been:

During the Smart Living Program, students take out a rally and decorate their house boards. During assembly, students take an initiative to give everyone more information in the form of Pep talk.

In the month of June 2017, we had our Orientation Program and we opened with great confidence and positivity and stepped into our very first academic year at the Keelkattalai Branch.

We conducted a month long bridge course to train our children academically, irrespective of their previous syllabus. Our children were slowly initiated into the Curriculum.
